In 1942, as a result of the attack on Pearl Harbor, the U.S. Government relocated over one hundred thousand Japanese Americans to internment camps within the Intermountain West. One such camp was the Minidoka Camp northeast of Twin Falls. These books highlight the tragedy, as well as illuminate the experiences of the people who lived through one of the most controversial eras of American history.
